We would like to take this opportunity to congratulate on your child being selected to an all-star team.

With the honor of being selected, you have the responsibility to get your child to games and practices and to work at tournaments hosted by your ABA program. The main responsibility that we as league directors are concerned about is proper behavior by all our fans, parents and players.

A true fan is at the game to cheer and encourage their child and team. They should not boo the opposing players or stomp their feet and make noise while the other team is shooting free throws. This is poor sportsmanship and only causes problems. Paying admission to a game does NOT give you a right to criticize officials or coaches. If you have a problem, you should contact your league director to register a complaint.

During the invitational tournaments, we will be aware of the behavior of our parents and fans. As parents/guardians you are responsible for the behavior of your relatives and friends that come to watch your child's games. Any individual that cannot behave will have to leave the gym and not return. If a group of fans are causing problems, their team will be eliminated for the remainder of the season. Zero Tolerance is in effect.

We hope that all our parents, fans and coaches will make this a positive all-star season for our ABA players and ourselves.

We are asking that parents/guardians sign this letter and give it to your coach. Your signature verifies that you have read this letter and will show good sportsmanship at all games.
